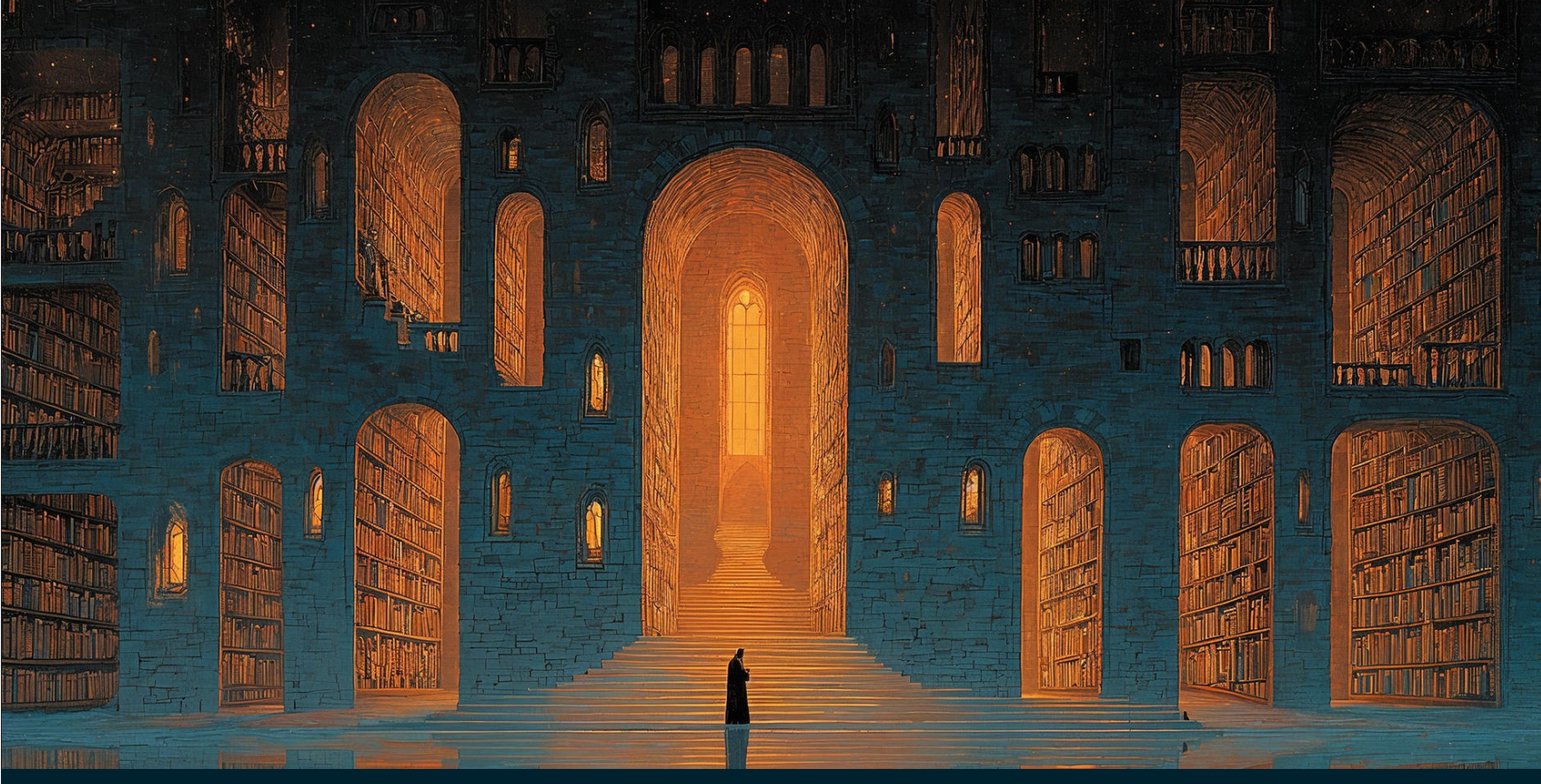

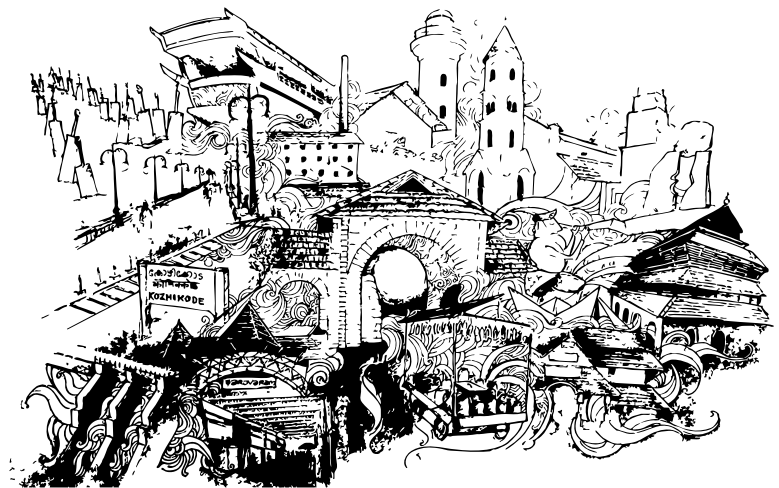
Objectives
